A Checklist

I. Get to know your students

Read and re-read the IEP's

Review testing data and progress notes

Mark calendar for IEP and re-evaluation dates

Make a list of accommodations for each student

Make a list of services for each student

Meet the general education teachers

Make sure everyone working with a student has a copy of their IEP

Prepare all assistive technology, get training if necessary

III. Cover wall and hall space

Meet with assistants

Meet with other special education teachers

Begin to organize students into group based on educational and behavioral needs

Write a letter introducing yourself to parents, provide your contact information (do not give your cellphone number).

V. Communicate with and special requests for parents

Make a list of required school supplies to be provided by parents Decide how you will communicate with parents Decide if you will require parents to send a snack each day
